

BOY SCOUT TROOP 458 - CAMP JOB DESCRIPTIONS FOR SENIOR PATROL LEADER

Responsibilities of Camp Leadership

These are the acting scout leaders for the camp. These are the most important jobs. The camp leaders direct the troop and the patrols to make sure the camp runs smoothly and everyone has a job

Senior Patrol Leader/Patrol Leader

1. Act as the senior scout of the camp/patrol. Report to the Scoutmaster/SPL.
2. Determine duty roster assignments
3. Oversee camp/Patrol
4. Mentor the young scouts with tasks, skills and expectations
5. Work with Ranger on roster and briefings (SPL)

Assistant Senior Patrol Leader

1. Assist the SPL/PL with tasks
2. Learn how to run the camp
3. Fill in for SPL/PL when not available

Troop Quartermaster and Patrol Quartermasters

1. Make sure camp equipment is ready for camp, report to Scoutmaster/Troop QM
2. Review meal plans, coordinate common foods and equipment (ketchup, mustard, beverages).
3. Troop Quartermaster leads and oversees the Patrol Quartermasters
4. Patrol Quartermasters oversee the equipment handling of their patrol
5. Responsible for the check-out and check in off camp equipment
 - a. Quartermasters are in charge of the troop equipment in and out of the trailer. No one else!
6. Make sure patrol boxes are put away clean and complete
7. Make sure tents are put away clean, dry and complete
 - a. Send tents home with scouts to dry if necessary

Camp specific jobs:

Sanitary Crew

- Trash Pickup - keep bags in the cans, carry full ones down to the dumpster
- Recycling – Keep bags in the cans, carry the full ones down to the recycling
- Latrine check – Stock with waterless hand sanitizer, check toilet paper, make sure clean at checkout time
- Hand Wash - Maintain the Hand wash bucket with water and soap
- Hot Water: Keep Hot water available throughout camp for dishes

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Axe Yard Crew:

- set up axe yard
- gather wood
- start/keep fires ready for cooking lunch & dinner (if necessary)
- set up water for dousing
- Role model and demand safety

Beverage Crew:

- Make sure there is hot water and scout preferred drinks available all day
- Make sure the beverage area is clean and orderly

Patrol Chef:

- Planning and leading meals for your patrol
- Follow the Camp cooking planner

Meal Cleanup Crew –

- Prepare wash basins for mess kit washing
- washing utensils & pots and pans
- Cleanup kitchen and cooking areas
